


LIVING ABOVE THE LINE



Living above the line is centered on abiding in Christ. As we trust in the finished work of the cross, allowing Holy Spirit to transform us, we move into greater dependency on God and see ourselves and our abilities in increasing humility in contrast to God's character. This does not mean we will never experience trials, hurts and tribulations; we live in a fallen world, but we depend on God for meeting our needs. We are free from the prison of our flesh and old corrupted beliefs systems that tormented us. We live a life of victory.

As a result, we experience the fruit of the Spirit: love, peace, patience, joy, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. When we are abiding in Christ, trusting Him for all our needs, we are a blessing to others.

The coach understands the role of a servant leader, one who puts others first and submits himself to God in all relationships and circumstances.

How do we test ourselves? How do we become aware of where we are operating? God is seeking hearts who love him more than anything else. The quickest and most effective question we can ask ourselves is this. Is your love for God greater than what you are doing right now?

Colossians 3:1-4
